• In early July you will receive a link to the Powderhorn Art Fair Preview. The Preview is a digital publication that highlights the artists, vendors and activities at the Fair. In 2017, it attracted thousands of readers. It is a great way to promote your booth and the Fair to your network.

BEFORE THE FAIR

Forms & Taxes

Ensure forms are completed and submitted to PPNA prior to the Fair weekend or at check in.

- **ST19:** We are required by Minnesota law to have sales and use tax form ST-19 on file for all participants. Supply a completed form prior to the Fair or during Friday check-in.

- Download the MN Sales & Use Tax Booklet (http://www.revenue.state.mn.us/Forms_and_Instructions/sales_tax_booklet.pdf)
- MN Sales Tax Number: All artists (except wearable fiber artists) must have a MN Tax ID number to participate. Please bring your MN Tax ID number with you. MN sales tax for non-wearable art is 7.775%.

CHECK IN

Check in Friday, August 3rd between 12:00 and 8:00 p.m. at the main park entrance on 15th Avenue South.

- All vehicles must be out of the Park by 8:30 pm
- If you cannot check in on Friday, you can check in on Saturday between 6:30 and 8:30 a.m. Please notify Ashley Bradford if this is a need. All vehicles must be out of the park by 9:00 a.m..

Please make every attempt to arrive Friday to allow ample time to set up your booth!

LOAD IN

- All standard size vehicles move clockwise around the lake for load-in/load-out.
- All oversize vehicles move clockwise for load-in and counter clockwise for load-out.
- The City of Minneapolis requires you to have a permit for overnight street parking if your vehicle is large. There is no fee. If you require a permit obtain one as you enter the main park entrance for check-in.
- · Who needs a permit? Exhibitors only, trucks greater than 3 tons, trailers, RVs.
- Permits must be displayed on the dashboard of vehicle and on the trailer.

Because of crowd size, safety and other related concerns; load out times on Saturday and Sunday may vary slightly.

WHILE YOU'RE HERE

SAFETY

- Severe Weather: In case of severe weather (i.e. tornado, etc), Please go to the park building for shelter (see map in program).
- First Aid: PAF has 2 EMTs on site at all times
- Watch For Children and other pedestrians/bikers when driving through the park.

OVERNIGHTS & REENTRY

- Overnights: Park Police will be on site from 7 pm 6 am Friday and Saturday. Any items or property left on site are the sole responsibility of the artist. We recommend you take valuables off-site each night. Powderhorn Art Fair assumes no responsibility in the event of loss or theft.
- Re-entry: Artist vehicles line up on WEST Side of 15th Avenue and traffic flows begins at 6:30 pm on Saturday and 5:30 pm on Sunday. Food vendor and oversized vehicles line up on EAST Side of 15th Avenue and traffic flows begins at 7 pm on Saturday and 6 pm on Sunday.

AMENITIES FOR VENDORS

- **Booth Sitters:** Groups of volunteer booth sitters will randomly approach artists for coverage and are available between 11:30 am 4:30 pm.
- Artist Lounge: Open Saturday & Sunday From 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in the park building.
- The 2017 Artist Lounge will offer snacks, beverages, indoor restrooms and air conditioning. This space is exclusively for artists, staff and volunteers.

JUDGING & AWARDS

Judging for awards will take place on Saturday. Award recipients will be posted Sunday in the Artist's Lounge.

LOAD OUT

Safety First: Please use extreme caution while driving in the Park.

We have created a staggered Load-out schedule. We will have a traffic crew to assist you in this procedure.

- Standard size vehicles must move clockwise around the lake for load-in/load-out
- Oversize vehicles move clockwise for load-in and counterclockwise for load-out.
- Oversize: When preparing to leave park grounds, please call Ashley @ 612.722.4817 and she will ensure a traffic assistant aids your departure.

Times for vehicle load out:

- Artists: 1/2 Hour after event closes. Sat 6:30 pm, Sun 5:30 pm.
- Food Vendors: 1 hour after event closes. Sat 7 pm, Sun 6 pm.
- Oversized vehicles (artists/food vendors): 11/2 hours after event closes Sat 7:30 pm, Sun 6:30 pm.
